# THE ICIRT STATS ARE OUT. THEY DON'T LIE...

76% of consumers surveyed stated that having iCIRT rated players delivering homes has changed their negative perception of the industry, post Opal and Mascot Towers





## CHEAPER LENDING...

Several funders have indicated they are prepared to give developers cheaper lending rates if they are iCIRT rated





#### DISCOUNTED INSURANCE FOR DEVELOPERS...

Resilience Insurance will discount those developers taking out Decennial Liability Insurance – thereby incentivising developers to get rated





# CAN RECOMMEND...

Rated developers prefer contracting with rated builders – this is a huge incentive for builders giving them an instant market advantage





# 80% ICIRT RENEWAL...

80% of rated players are renewing their iCIRT rating – confirming their first year of being rated clearly delivered benefit
